- Contributing to preliminary and detailed multidisciplinary technical studies during the prospecting, site assessment, EIA, consenting and design phases of all renewable developments
- Coordinating external consultants to undertake Environmental Impact Assessments (EIA) and planning/consenting submissions.

- Managing and monitoring project risks and budget and report to management team on project progress
- Developing and implementing an effective stakeholder and communications strategy to engage with and build trusted relationships with landowners, local communities, planning authorities, statutory consultees and other key stakeholders, participating in site and community visits and meetings
